St. Ambrose, St. Gregory, and St. Cecilia are depicted in the three windows of the choir loft because each of them is associated with music in some way: St. Ambrose, because he is traditionally credited as having composed chants and hymns, some of which continue to be used today; St. Gregory for his well-known Gregorian chants; and St. Cecilia because she is the patron saint of music.
