St. James the Greater is depicted in the next window holding a walking staff, as he is often associated with pilgrims and pilgrimage. The shells at the bottom of the window also demonstrate this association, as they are a traditional symbol of the Camino de Santiago (the Way of St. James), which leads to the Shrine in Spain where it is believed his remains are housed. At the top of this window are the words "Hail Full of Grace," the Angel Gabriel's greeting to Mary at the Annunciation.
